The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Angola, Indiana was called to order by Chair Richard M. Hickman at 6:30 p.m. City Hall, 210 N Public Square. Herbert recorded the minutes.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Member Olson moved to approve the March 7, 2022 minutes. Member Hickman seconded the motion. The motion carried 3-0.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

City Engineer Cope presented a letter provided by Sutton's Deli requesting the city look at improving drainage in the alley behind 140 and 160 N Public Square. Cope said she had looked at the request and it consist of two projects. Project one would include improvements in thew alley including trench drains at a cost of \$19,560. Project two would include piping from the alley to the storm sewer. Project one could be a partnership between the city and Sutton's and project two should be the city's responsibility. Member Olson moved that the city partner with Sutton's Deli on project one and split the cost 50/50. Member Martin seconded the motion. the motion carried 3-0.



DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS


Police Chief Whitmire reported that the department had hired two new officers, Guy Emberton and Allie Curdes.
