The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Angola, Indiana was called to order at 7:02 p.m. at City Hall, 210 North Public Square with Mayor Richard M. Hickman presiding. Council Members Gary L. Crum, David A. Olson, Kathleen G. Armstrong, David B. Martin, and Jerold D. McDermid answered roll. No council member was absent. Clerk-Treasurer Ryan P. Herbert recorded the minutes.

Council Member Olson moved to approve the April 17, 2023 minutes. Council Member Armstrong seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Armstrong moved to approve. Council Member McDermid seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Ordinance No. 1730-2023, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANGOLA MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 2 ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL, CHAPTER 12.15 DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, was read by title and presented to Council on second reading. Council Member Crum moved to approve. Council Member McDermid seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Economic Development and Planning Director Jennifer Barclay introduced Mackenzie Bird who started last week with the city as the Community Coordinator. Mackenzie has started working on the Fourth of July parade which will include a float contest this year. Also, Mackenzie is working on the new downtown sculptures that will be installed in June. This year one of the sculptures will be provided by Impact.

Fire Chief Doug Call reported that the Fire Department will be hosting an open house after the Fourth of July parade this year to celebrate the department's 150th anniversary.
