APPROVAL OF MINUTES

ORDER OF BUSINESS

Member Martin moved to approve the Agreement to Dissolve and Extinguish Easement with West Commons, LLC. Member Olson seconded the motion. Discussion followed. The motion carried 3-0.

Member Martin moved to approve the request by MSD of Steuben County to connect the property at 1769 S Old US Hwy 27 (bus depot) to city sanitary sewer. Member Olson seconded the motion. Discussion followed. Both City Engineer Cope and Wastewater Superintendent Gaff reported they had no concerns and approved. The motion to approve carried 3-0.

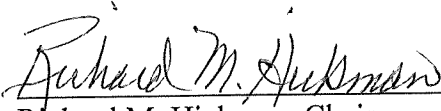
