

August 18, 2025

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Angola, Indiana was called to order at 7:30 p.m. at City Hall, 210 North Public Square with Mayor David B. Martin presiding. Council Members Randy Coffey, David A. Olson, Charles P. Dowe, Jennifer L. Sharkey, and Jerold D. McDermid answered roll. No Council Member was absent. Clerk-Treasurer Ryan P. Herbert recorded the minutes.

Among those present were City Attorney Kim Shoup, City Engineer Amanda Cope, Economic Development and Planning Director Retha Hicks, Superintendent Chad Ritter, Park Superintendent Matt Hanna, Water Superintendent Mitch Sattison, and Police Patrol Officer Allie Curdes.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Council Member Coffey moved to approve August 4, 2025 minutes. Council Member McDermid seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Minutes of the July 7, 2025 Board of Public Works and Safety meeting was presented for Council information.

<u>UNFINISHED BUSINESS</u>

Public hearing regarding the proposed additional appropriation to the Park Cumulative Building Fund was open by Mayor Martin at 7:05 p.m. There being no public comment the public hearing was considered closed at 7:06 p.m. Ordinance No. 1785-2025, ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF ANGOLA, INDIANA PARK CUMULATIVE BUILDING FUND, was read by title and presented to Council on second reading. Council Member McDermid moved to approve. Council Member Dowe seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0. Ordinance No. 1785-2025, ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF ANGOLA, INDIANA PARK CUMULATIVE BUILDING FUND, was then read by title and

presented to Council on third and final reading. Council Member McDermid moved to approve. Council Member Coffey seconded the motion. The motion to approve on third and final reading carried 5-0. (renumbered to 1784-2025)

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Economic Development and Planning Director noted that Trine Fest will be happening this downtown this weekend. Also, planning is underway for Cruise to the Monument on September 17th.

City Engineer Cope reported that the preconstruction meeting for the Pokagon Project was held last week. Contractors will start moving in materials in September and major construction will begin in October with the bore under I-69 around 400 N. Construction will be in full swing through July of 2027. Also, Community Crossing Projects started today with Mark and Sarah Drives and will move on to other streets around the city. Those projects should be completed by Thanksgiving.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Angola, Indiana that Title 10 Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 10.25 Parking is being amended by the text of existing provisions in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in this style type:

Section 1. Section 10.25.130 Parking prohibited at all times is amended to read as follows:

When signs are erected giving notice, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in this schedule:



2026 FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT

This agreement is between the **Town of Fremont**, Indiana and **the City of Angola**, Indiana. For good and sufficient mutual and reciprocal consideration, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The City of Angola Fire Department shall provide firefighting services and other appropriate emergency services to the residents of the portion of Jamestown Township as outlined in Blue on the attached map to the extent reasonably possible, taking into account the Angola Fire Department's manpower, equipment, and responsibilities to the residents of its home area. The Angola Fire Department shall also provide rescue activities in the designated area, subject to approval of the Steuben County Emergency Medical Services Director.
- 2. The sum payable to the City of Angola Fire Department is contingent upon an executed agreement for the year 2025 between the Town of Fremont and Jamestown Township. The Town of Fremont shall pay the City of Angola Fire Department the sum of \$82,290.00 payable as follows:
 - A. Prior to June 30, 2026 the sum of \$41,145.00; and
 - B. Prior to December 31, 2026 the sum of \$41,145.00
- 3. That said payments are by the parties deemed to be in full settlement and discharge of the Town of Fremont's share of all insurance costs, clothing, automobile, and other allowances required or permitted by law to be provided to members of the Angola Fire Department, it being agreed that such legally required insurance and allowances will be procured by the Angola Fire Department.
- 4. The term of this agreement shall be from January 1 through December 31 of the year 2026. It may be renewed annually by the parties and any such renewal may contain modifications of the provisions herein.
- 5. This Agreement is subject to approval by the State Board of Accounts, Department of Local Government Finance, and all other relevant government agencies.
