OLD BUSINESS

Sheets Family Park Update- Hanna reported that maintenance staff have been working with the Water Department over the past several days to complete winterization of the park. He noted that a few portable toilets have been placed on-site for family use. Hanna further reported that the park's reopening timeline is now being assessed on a day-by-day basis. Hanna mentioned there will be some ticket items that will have to be addressed and fixed in the spring. Member Carpenter addressed his concern on not having an employee on site. Hanna explained it will be handled like any of our other parks, with having operating hours, and cameras on site for any vandalism. Hanna said if someone is needed full time, we have the resources to accomplish that.




NEW BUSINESS
