

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1091-2002
CONCERNING SEWER CONNECTION CHARGES

WHEREAS, the City of Angola (“City”) has heretofore constructed and has in operation a sewage treatment facility for the purpose of collecting and disposing in a sanitary manner the sewage works of the City; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-9-23 provides that a municipal legislative body shall, by ordinance, establish just and equitable fees for the services rendered by the sewage works; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council finds that based upon the advice of its financial advisor, the existing charges are insufficient to enable the City to properly operate and maintain its sewage treatment works facility, pay debt service on its bonds, and fund additions and improvements to the system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Angola, Steuben County, Indiana:

Section 1. Connection charge.

Base connection charge:

<u>Water Meter Size</u>	
5/8”	\$ 690
3/4”	1,035
1”	1,725
1½”	3,450
2”	5,520
3”	10,350
4”	17,250
6”	34,500

For connections occurring after 2003, the connection charge shall be increased each year by the amount as determined by the following schedule:

<u>Water Meter Size</u>	<u>Per Year</u>
5/8”	\$ 170
3/4”	255
1”	425
1½”	850
2”	1,360
3”	2,550
4”	4,250
6”	8,500

Section 2. Effective date.

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect January 1, 2003 from and after its passage and execution by the Mayor.
