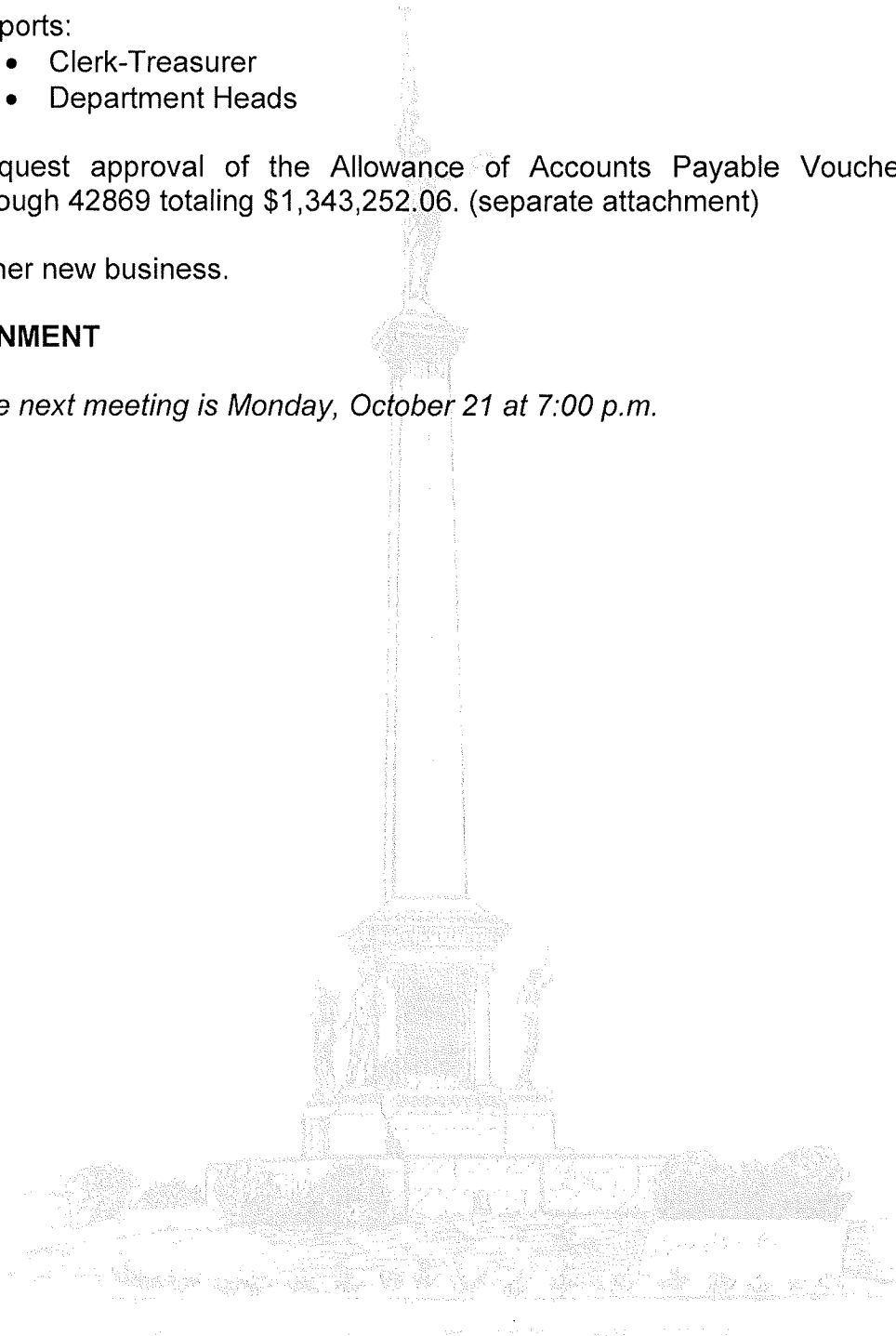

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Angola, Indiana was called to order at 7:01 p.m. at City Hall, Council Chambers, 210 North Public Square, with Mayor Richard M. Hickman presiding. Councilmembers Gary L. Crum, David A. Olson, Kathleen G. Armstrong, David B. Martin, and Joseph M. Hysong answered roll call. No Councilmember was absent. Clerk-Treasurer Debra A. Twitchell recorded the minutes.

Present were Chief of Police Stu Hamblen, City Attorney Kim Shoup, City Engineer Amanda Cope, Deputy Clerk Tammy Onofrietti, Water Superintendent Tom Selman, and Economic Development and Planning Director Vivian Likes.

Also present were Ashlee Hoos of *The Herald Republican* and Colin Meadowcroft of WLKI.

#### REMARKS BY THE MAYOR

Mayor Hickman reminded everyone to attend the 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Cruise to the Monument. A proclamation will be read honoring Dan Campbell. Campbell was very instrumental in bringing this event to Angola.

#### APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Councilmember Olson moved to approve the September 3, 2019 minutes. Councilmember Armstrong seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

#### UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Ordinance No. 1618-2019, AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION OF ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF ANGOLA, INDIANA FOR THE YEAR 2020, was read by title and presented to Council for third and final reading. Councilmember Martin moved to approve. Councilmember Hysong seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0. (1%; 27 pay days)

#### NEW BUSINESS

Bids for the Mechanic Street/Oak Street Sewer Rehabilitation were opened and read aloud by City Engineer Cope. Project estimate was \$63,900.00.

Granite Inliner \$83,048.00

Insituform Technologies USA, LLC \$69,994.00

Councilmember Martin moved to award the bid to the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder if funds were available. Clerk-Treasurer Twitchell stated so. Councilmember Hysong seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Resolution No. 2019-762, A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY OF ANGOLA FOR THE GENERAL FUND AND FORWARDED TO COMMON COUNCIL FOR THEIR ACTION AND PASSAGE PURSUANT TO IC 6-1.1-18.6, was read by title and presented to Council for approval. Councilmember Olson moved to approve. Councilmember Crum seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0. (Information Technology Department)

Mayor Hickman presented the 2020 Budget. A budget workshop was scheduled for Monday, September 23 at 5:00 p.m.

Clerk-Treasurer Twitchell presented the Budget Management Report which is presented annually in conjunction with the budget presentation. The report is historical, current, and projected revenues, expenditures, and cash balances for governmental funds over a period of eight years and may be used as reference tool during the annual budget process. The Report compiles information on operating, capital, and pension funds and includes the City's 2019 amended budget and the 2020 proposed budget. An integral part of the Report are the Notes and Assumptions section.

The Clerk-Treasurer's Depository Statement and Cash Reconciliation for the month of August 2019 were presented for Council information.

#### DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Water Superintendent Selman reported hydrant flushing will take place the next two weeks. They will begin in the northeast corner of the City.

Economic Development and Planning Director Likes reported longtime resident Veryl Carpenter would be on the Wednesday, September 18 Honor Flight. The Honor Flight Northeast Indiana provides four flights opportunities each year to take our honored veterans to see their memorials in Washington D.C. Each flight is planned for approximately 85 veterans and their guardians to travel to Washington D.C. for a tour of the memorials that were built to honor their valiant serviced to our country. Not only did Carpenter serve our country, Veryl has served on several boards throughout the City and is currently a board member of the Plan Commission and the Parks and Recreation Board.

Likes also reported Ken Wilson with JICI will be going before the Plan Commission in November with development plans for Terrace Apartments. They are proposing two buildings and rent will be at market rate.

#### APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTS PAYABLE VOUCHERS

Councilmember Martin moved to approve the Allowance of Accounts Payable Vouchers 42324 through 42577 totaling \$920,910.14 which includes interfund transfers of \$95,606.77. Councilmember Hysong seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

**SEPTEMBER 23, 2019**

A special meeting of the Common Council of the City of Angola, Indiana was called to order at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall, Council Chambers, 210 North Public Square, with Mayor Richard M. Hickman presiding. Councilmembers Gary L. Crum, David A. Olson, Kathleen G. Armstrong, David B. Martin, and Joseph M. Hysong answered roll call. No Councilmember was absent. Clerk-Treasurer Debra A. Twitchell recorded the minutes.

Present were Chief of Police Stu Hamblen, City Attorney Kim Shoup, City Engineer Amanda Cope, Accounts Payable Clerk Ryan Herbert, Fire Chief Mike Meek, Assistant Chief of Police Ken Whitmire, Park Superintendent Matt Hanna, Building Commission Scott Lehman, Water Superintendent Tom Selman, Economic Development and Planning Director Vivian Likes, Street Commissioner Doug Anderson, and Systems Administrator Nathan Armstrong.

The 2020 Budget was reviewed department by department. A correction was made to the Municipal Building (Public Safety Building) budget to include a budget for electric and gas utility services. Discussion was had. A public hearing will be held October 7 and adoption is scheduled for October 21.

On another matter, there was discussion regarding the Steuben County Courthouse Renovation Project. Information was submitted by the Steuben County Commissioners dated August 30, 2019. The Commissioners plan to attend the October 7 Council meeting. The project calls for a new addition to the courthouse on the south side of the current courthouse and be built into Gale Street. Discussion followed. Although the Commissioners letter did not make a specific request vacating Gale Street, Economic Development and Planning Director Likes stated and City Attorney Shoup concurred that the matter at hand is whether or not Council will vacate the street. If Council agrees to vacate, then the matter will go before the Historic Preservation Commission because the courthouse is in the designated historic district; then to the Board of Zoning Appeals for variances; and then to the Plan Commission for review and approval of the development plan. More discussion followed. No action was taken by Council.

There being no further business, the meeting was considered adjourned at 6:07 p.m.

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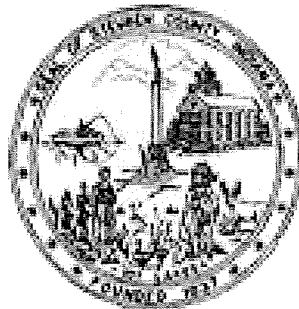

# **STEUBEN COUNTY COURTHOUSE RENOVATION PROJECT**

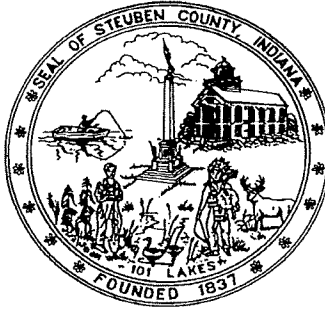

The Steuben County Commissioners are scheduled to present to the Angola Common Council on Monday, October 7, 2019, and would like to submit the following information and the attached diagram for your review.

The Courthouse Study Committee has been meeting for several years to discuss and address ADA compliance issues, to examine the possible renovation of the current Courthouse and to consider either an addition to the current Courthouse or the possibility of building a new standalone Judicial Complex.

After reviewing potential designs, the Commission Board and the Courthouse Study Committee have determined that building a new addition, attached to the current Courthouse, would be the best remedy to the current problems. It is proposed that the new addition will house three (3) new and updated Courtrooms, have ground level ADA compliant access and parking, direct ground level transport for the Sheriff's Department, a secure prisoner elevator and holding cells, a new public elevator and increased parking for staff.

It was also determined the best location for the new addition would be on the south side of the current Courthouse and with the permission of the Angola Common Council, be built into Gale Street. By closing and utilizing Gale Street, security can be increased, handicap accessibility will be created and parking may be diminished around the Mound.

Enclosed is further information for your review. Due to the fact that an official Request for Proposals has not yet been sent out for this Project, we cannot submit a diagram that is to scale or proposed layouts for each floor.
