



2021 Sculptures Angola - SUMMER

CALL TO ARTISTS

2019 marked the first year for the “Sculptures Angola”. This project originally began as the fruition of Angola’s Hometown Collaboration Initiative (HCI) and the City of Angola Mayor’s Arts Council. The Mayor’s Arts Council will be adding a four (4) smaller sculptures to Commercial, Historic, Downtown Angola.

Sculptures that are owned by artists will be on loan to this program for one (1) year. **Application deadline is Friday, April 2, 2021.** **Priority will be given outdoor sculptures that have visual appeal to all ages.** This event is open to local and national artists. Four (4) outdoor sculptures are estimated to be accepted with an honorarium of \$1000.00/each. There is no additional travel or hotel.

Eligibility

Artist must be at least 18 years of age. Submitted sculptures must be original works created within the last five (5) years, suitable for outdoor display and for sale. Entries will be critiqued based on artistic merit, materials, construction, durability, maintenance, public access, public safety, variety of entries, durability in an outdoor setting, and size. The art will be selected by members of the City of Angola Mayor’s Arts Council. Digital submissions (preferred) should be in .jpg format and under 4MB in size and labeled with the last name of the artist and the name of the work. (example: smith_name of work)

Artists will be notified of the selection committee’s decision by Friday, April 16, 2021.

The date of installation will be Friday June 4, 2021, to be finished by 1:00pm.

Along with **entry form, image(s), and artist biography/resume.** All entries must be postmarked (or email dated) by **Friday April 2, 2021,** (midnight). Mailed applications must be received by the City by April 9, 2021. Emailed entries are preferred. The City of Angola will not be responsible for mail that is delayed and not received by the City of Angola after April 9, 2021. Please send emails to: mdavis@angolain.org

General Information:

- Outdoor sculpture lease - \$1000.00
- Artists are responsible for transportation, installation, and removal at site.
- The City of Angola will not be liable for accidents or damage associated and during transportation and installation to and from the installation venue.
- Locations for the installation will be determined by the City of Angola.
- Concrete bases will be provided for the sculptures and are owned by the City of Angola and/or its partners unless a different arrangement is made with the City of Angola. Bases are 4ft long by 4 ft wide and a minimum of 5 inches high. Submitted work must be able to be affixed securely to this base.
- Any sales/leases of the sculptures will be conducted by the artists or their agent and will not involve the City of Angola.
- Sculptures are to remain on site for the duration of the project (June 2021 – June 2022) unless other arrangements have been made with the City of Angola.
- Artist retains copyright for sculpture and grants the City of Angola a license to take and distribute images of the sculptures for promotional purposes.



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- For payment to be made on the day of delivery and installation, a completed W9, matching the name of the entity or person to which payment will be made, **MUST** be received by the City of Angola by May 7, 2021 4:30pm.

Sculpture Requirements:

- Indicate how the sculpture is to be attached to a base. Bases are 4ftW X 4ftD X 5inchesH. Bolting is preferred. If the art must be welded, a steel base plate or steel strips should be securely attached to the bottom of the piece so they can be attached to the base. Welding will be done by the artist. A portable power supply along with welding equipment will be necessary from the artist.
- Sculptures are for public outdoor display and must be durable and constructed with safety in mind.
- Sculptures must be sealed to avoid rust bleeding onto pad and pedestal as well as installation location.
- Sculptures must be a minimum of 4feet high.

Criteria for picking sculptures:

- Mayor's Arts Council will review.
- Angola's Mayor's Arts Council will consider the proposal's artistic merit, materials, construction, durability, maintenance, public access, public safety, variety of entries, durability in an outdoor setting, and size.
- The Mayor's Arts Council may opt to not accept any of the submissions, in which case the selection process may be reopened.
