



Street Commissioner

The position oversees 8 full-time staff and 1 part-time staff and seasonal staff when applicable. The commissioner is responsible for the safety of all employees of the department.

The Angola Street Department is responsible for approximately 48 miles of city streets and 3,000 residential customers. Our services range from salt spreading and snow removal, leaf and yard waste pickup, various repair work on city streets, sign installation and maintenance and a variety of other responsibilities and services.

- Actively seek out and implement opportunities to incorporate operational efficiency and employee safety in support of continuous improvement
- Develop and manage annual budget
- Develop and maintain partnerships with all internal, inter-departmental and external relationships
