Applicant Qualifications

- Be at least 21 years of age and have not reached 36 years of age at the time of hire
- Be a high school graduate or possess a High School Equivalency or GED
- Possess a valid driver's license with an acceptable (insurable) driving record
- Have no record of felony convictions
- Have no misdemeanor conviction of domestic violence
- If prior military, be honorably discharged
- Hold current certifications in Firefighter I & II, EMR or EMT, NIMS 100, 200, 700 & 800, Hazmat Operations
- Valid CPAT required, within 12 months of issue at date of hire
- Be of good moral character and possess a high degree of honesty and integrity
- Possess an acceptable level of verbal and written skills to successfully execute the essential duties and functions of the job
- Possess an acceptable level of dexterity to successfully execute the essential duties and functions of the job
- Possess the ability to interact appropriately with the public, employees, team members, elected officials, and others
