Applicant Qualifications

- be a resident citizen of the United States of America
- be at least 21 years of age and have not reached 40 years of age at the time of appointment to the Department. Current members of the 1977 Pension fund are not restricted by the age 40 requirement.
- be a high school graduate or possess a High School Equivalency or GED
- possess a valid driver's license.
- have no record of felony convictions.
- have no misdemeanor conviction of domestic violence.
- if prior military, must be Honorably Discharged
- be of good moral character and possess a high degree of honesty and integrity.
- possess an acceptable level of verbal and written skills to successfully execute the essential duties and functions of the job.
- possess an acceptable level of dexterity to successfully execute the essential duties and functions of the job.
- possess the ability to interact appropriately with the public, team members, elected officials and others.

Wage

- 2023 Wage Range - \$1550.73 - \$2282.23 / bi-weekly (26 pays per year) – Starting wage is based upon applicable skills and experience.
