AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THE MS-4 ORDINANCE MAY BE ENFORCED THROUGH ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-6-9 provides that certain ordinances may be enforced administratively if an ordinance allowing such is adopted; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to enforce Ordinance 1159-2004, otherwise known as the "MS-4" ordinance through administrative proceedings;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Angola, Indiana, that Ordinance 1159-2004, the MS-4 ordinance, may be enforced through administrative proceedings. The administrative body before which the proceeding may be brought shall be known as the "Hearing Authority" and shall consist of a person designated by the Mayor to so serve. The Hearing Authority shall be an attorney-at-law and shall not otherwise be employed by the City. Said person shall be designated on a case-by-case basis. Said administrative proceedings shall be conducted in conformity with the applicable provisions of Indiana Code 36-1-6-9.
